- Updates to the mailing list spreadsheet were reviewed. Over 40 updates have been made in the past six months.
- Our website subscription has been extended another five years past the current expiration date, taking us through December 2, 2026. As a current customer, we received a 15% discount, which amounted to \$383 total.
- Because of changes in the event registration template, we cannot offer a “couples discount” (i.e. \$75 per couple and \$40 per individual). It was agreed to go with the template’s structure of \$40 per person, which will be \$80 per couple. We will still charge a late fee of \$10 per person after our early registration deadline of August 31, 2019. We will also not have a live band Saturday night to ensure the volume is not too loud for conversation.
